On entering this well-established property, you will experience the cool and tranquil surroundings, enormous trees, luscious foliage and beautiful gardens.

Rolling lawns, groomed hedges of Viburnum shrubs, mass groupings of Azaleas, Agapanthus, Clivia's and interesting varieties of Bromeliads forms the basis of this huge hotel garden.

Visitors can enjoy wondering through the garden where indigenous and exotic trees can be identified by tree tags. The well-known Fever Trees, Kiepersol, Mitzeeri, White Stinkwood and Gray Apple are very well presented, which also provide home to an abundance of indigenous birdlife.

With the 21st birthday celebrations of Fairview Hotel in 2017 the owners decided to establish a Cycad trail on the property.

The desire for the preservation of this unique ancient indigenous flora, which is well known for its slow growth, maturation and distribution and therefore so valuable and worth preservation developed over years, and with careful planning, researching and the valuable assistance of world renown cycad fundi's, Douglas Goode and Steve Trollip this resourceful project was executed and finalised.

a Variety of twenty-eight Encephalartos species can be sighted on route, planted in groups of three or more between other indigenous trees and shrubs, winding through the property of Fairview Hotel.
